

**CODY SHOOTING COMPLEX**  
**General Membership Meeting**  
**November 13, 2018**

The meeting was called to order by President Otis Smith at 6 pm. There were 10 officers and directors present. Two members at large attended as well. President Otis Smith asked for all to read the October meeting minutes and if no changes or additions a motion to accept. There were no changes or additions-Vice President Mike Cannella made a motion to accept the minutes – Director Dean Blackwell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Old Business:** President Otis Smith said that he called a special Board member meeting to go over the Governor's Magpul Shoot – to make changes and resubmit. Changes were made and the contract was signed. President Otis Smith will go before the County Commissioners to find out where the land expansion talks are. The land expansion is needed before the Governor's Magpul shoot-more space for stations. President Otis Smith

said that the Go Cam from Verizon will be mounted at the entry gate. There were approximately 11 shooters at the Basin Trap Club Turkey shoot -with Cody shooters coming home with about 15 turkeys. A great time was had by all in attendance.

**New Business:** President Otis Smith talked the range rental agreement. The fees need to be charged on a case by case event to those outside renters. No matter who rents an additional insured copy of their insurance policy needs to be sent before the shoot. President Otis Smith said that another position needs to be added – Secretary only and a membership person only. The combined duties are too consuming for one person. There also needs to be either the Treasurer or Vice President to collect fees for those renters that do not pay either prior or within 10 days of shoot. Vice President Mike Cannella said he would do that and would collect this week from a renter that has not paid - \$60. Youth Director Tiger McNeil said that he bought pipe for the water drainage problems over by Sporting Clays and Plinking Range – plans on putting pipe in before any paving occurs. Vice President Mike Cannella asked Tiger to come up with a plan. Youth Director Tiger McNeil also said that he has some skillets for the pistols range. The cost is \$250. The schools need to be contacted regarding youth shooting programs and or starting up a school shooting program.

No further business Youth Director Tiger McNeil called for adjournment with Treasurer Mike Schnell seconding the motion. Adjourned at 6:25 pm.
