

Cody Shooting Complex  
General Membership/Director's Meeting  
November 2020

The November Meeting was called to order at 6pm. There were 10 Directors and Board Members in attendance. The October Minutes were read and a motion to approve was made by Mike Schnell and seconded by Justin Esser. All voted to approve the minutes.

Otis brought up his continuing efforts to retrieve the monies due the complex from the Magpul shoot. He has been in contact with Chris Floyd from the governor's office to keep them aware of the situation. There have been discussions with a club member who is an attorney of the possibility of pursuing legal action against the promoter. A member, John Burns, has requested that Otis withhold his efforts in the event this promoter may wish to have this shoot here in the future. The Board members were quite vocal in their support of Otis pursuing the money due the club and not allowing this promoter to utilize our facility in the future. Apparently, the promoter is not bankrupt, as he claimed and is putting on shoots in Nevada. A motion was made by Bob Posner and seconded by Katie Brass to continue efforts to retrieve money due the club as well as informing all sponsors of the promoter's dishonesty. All voted in favor.

Treasurer Mike Schnell provided a detailed report of the club's finances.

The land expansion is continuing. The BLM has reported that the public comment period is closed and the transfer should be completed next month. The club is pursuing grant funding to assist with the cost of fencing the addition.

There being no additional business, a motion to adjourn was made at 6:20pm. The motion was made by Pete Kneip and seconded by Dean Blackwell. All voted in favor and the meeting was adjourned.
