## CODY SHOOTING COMPLEX GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING FEBRUARY 11, 2020

President Otis Smith called the meeting to order at 6 pm. All Officers were present as well as eight Directors. There were seven Members at Large in attendance. The January Meeting Minutes were read. There being no corrections, a motion to approve was made by Milt Allen and seconded by Pete Kneip. All voted in favor to accept the minutes.

Old/New Business: A discussion began regarding the installation of an ATM machine in the trap clubhouse. The company that provides the machine has decided it would be best if the club supplied their cash in the machine instead of him doing so. There is no cost to the club to have this machine. The club will realize a \$.50 commission per transaction. A motion to proceed with this installation was made by Dean Blackwell and seconded by Pete Kneip. All voted in favor of this motion. The discussion proceeded into the acceptance of credit cards for membership payments online. Member Josiah Bullock offered his services as a web designer to assist with this setup. Ugo Carrafa, Katie Brass and Josiah Bullock will meet as a committee to set this program up. Mailin Foster spoke of the good turnout he is having for indoor gallery. He has also received interest in sponsoring a Schutzen Match as our facility is approximately half way for those living in southern Wyoming and those coming down from Montana. He received approval to pursue this match, with assistance offered for workers. He also asked for permission to place 25 yd and 50 yd markers on the edges of the rifle range. Chief Range Officer, Ugo Carrafa, will assist with this. He also expressed interest in pursuing Rimfire Silhouette with falling plate rack silhouette targets. Tiger McNeil has started the 4-H program for the year. They will be utilizing the indoor range on Monday evenings until the weather improves. Treasurer discussed the Profit and Loss Report for 2019. Insurance and Utility expenses are quite substantial and will continue increasing. A discussion to raise the annual membership dues to \$100.00 and \$110.00 for new members (\$10.00 one time fee for gate card). Katie Brass made the motion to approve this increase, seconded by Milt Allen. All voted in favor to approve the increase beginning July 1, 2020. Anyone who renews or joins prior to this date, will pay the \$80.00 and \$90.00 currently being charged. Finally a vote to reverse the water extension to the camping area was approved. The county would have required an extensive waste disposal system and it was determined to be cost prohibitive.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Milt Allen and seconded by Tiger McNeil. All voted in favor. Meeting adjourned at 6:50 pm.
