

# GENERAL RANGE RULES

## CODY SHOOTING COMPLEX

The Range Safety Officer has absolute authority on the range.

**No alcohol** may be consumed in or around any shooting area until all firearms of all shooters are empty and secured. No exceptions will be allowed. Violators will be expelled from the range.

**No illegal drug** use is allowed at any time. Violators will be expelled from the range.

Never bring a loaded firearm onto the range. The **only** exception is a holstered handgun.

Follow the NRA basic safety rules:

Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.

Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.

Always keep the firearm unloaded until ready to use.

During a **Cease Fire**, unload all firearms; open and clear all actions and table all firearms. **Do Not** handle any firearm or approach a shooting position.

Be thoroughly familiar with the operational and safety features of all your firearms.

Before using your firearm, be sure it is in good working order and the bore is clear.

Use only ammunition that is recommended by the manufacturer of your firearm and be certain the ammo matches the caliber of the firearm. Be cautious of reloaded ammo.

Have only one firearm with the proper matching ammunition on the bench at a time.

Use eye and ear protection while on or near an active firing line.

Be aware of your actions and those of other shooters on the firing line.

Clean up your firing position and targets and properly dispose of all trash.

Pick up your expended brass to keep or properly dispose of. It is **not** biodegradable.

Shooters are responsible for their guns, ammunition, and equipment.

All minors shall be supervised by a responsible adult.

All dogs shall be tethered, leashed, or otherwise contained at all times.

Report any safety violations or any unsafe conditions to a Range Safety Officer immediately.
